### Funds Raised in 2019/2020:

- Required to use funds before the end of the 2020/2021 school year
- As of today, there is \$36,400 in the council bank account
- Suggestion for Chromebooks for each Grade 1-5 classroom Need 60 Chromebooks – 5 Chromebooks x 12 classrooms (Voted in favour of spending council funds on Chromebooks)
  - Several parents are investigating where Chromebooks may be purchased at a "cost effective" rate
  - Mr Kanalec to request specs from Mr Gard
- Suggestion for increasing teacher/ECE allotment from \$200 to \$400 (Voted in favour of increasing council allotment per teacher/ECE to \$400)
- Suggestion for a boot tray for each child to keep the floor dry
- Suggestion for online parent engagement will also help to keep virtual school families connected
- Suggestion for ponchos for wet weather either a full class set or a handful per class

#### 2020-2021 Council Elections:

## Staffing

### Safe and Caring Schools

- COVID Operational Guidelines – policies and procedures change regularly, and Mr K will send updates to families, as needed
- Back to School Confirmation Form if students are off with COVID-related symptoms, they are required to submit this form when returning to school

### **Teaching and Learning**

- Changes to reporting policy for the 2020-2021 school year:
  - The purpose of this memo is to provide a Kindergarten to Grade 8 Reporting Schedule for 2020-2021. The COVID-19 pandemic has created exceptional circumstances for teaching and learning. A staggered start to the school year, and students adjusting to a modified learning environment due to provincial public health guidelines, has created some many challenges. We acknowledge that the return to school (face-to-face or virtual) will take some time and the early part of the school year may focus on mental health, well-being and the development of a safe, inviting and inclusive learning community. The rate of progress during this school year may differ from previous years due to the impact of COVID-19 on student learning.
