- 30 credits: ( 18 compulsory and 12 optional)

4 English, one per grade level

2 Science
1 Canadian geography
1 Canadian history
1 Arts (dance, drama, media, music, visual arts) 1 Health and physical education

A maximum of two credits in Cooperative Education and two credits in French can count as compulsory credits.

## LITERACY

## REQUIREMENT

Students must write the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT), which is created and marked by EQAO. Students who write the
OSSLT and who have been unsuccessful at least once are eligible to take the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Course (OLC4O).

## COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Students must complete a minimum of 40 hours of community involvement prior to graduation.

An indication of completion will be entered on the student's Ontario Student Transcript when the 40 hours have been submitted.

The selection and managemen of the involvement is to be directed by the student and approved by the secondary school.
Activities may take place inside or outside the school. If inside, activities may not be part of a credit program.
-The student may not displace a worker who would normally have been paid to perform the same function.

- Community involvement may begin in the summer after Grade 8.
