To apply for the Early French Immersion Program (SK entry) for September 2021, applications must be completed online between <u>November 2 and November 27, 2020.</u> An offer of placement in the program (not a specific school) is guaranteed to all on-time applicants and will be made in the weeks following the close of the application window.

Please note: Families with an older sibling currently enrolled in the same French program and who will be in attendance next year are still required to complete an online application for the new student. Please select the "sibling option" within the online application.
