Here are some updates:

<u>Important Toronto Public Health Update</u>

Toronto Public Health has **modified the student screening tool** to include an additional question regarding siblings showing symptoms. The following changes will take effect on Monday, December 7th.

- •If the student is symptomatic, their household siblings must isolate as well.
- •If the student has symptoms and has an alternative diagnosis, siblings do not need to self-isolate.
- •If the student has symptoms and tests negative for COVID-19, siblings can return to school.

Grade 3 Universal Screening Process

As a result of the COVID 19 pandemic and staggered entry to school, the annual TDSB's Universal Screening Process using the Canadian Cognitive Abilities Test 7 (CCAT 7) for Grade 3 students was delayed. This test provides information to classroom teachers about the strengths and learning needs of each student in order to better support teachers with programming. The CCAT 7, which typically has been administered in October, will now be administered on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>December 8th</u> by Ms. London and Ms. Rowan.
