(Kahoot is an online quiz game)

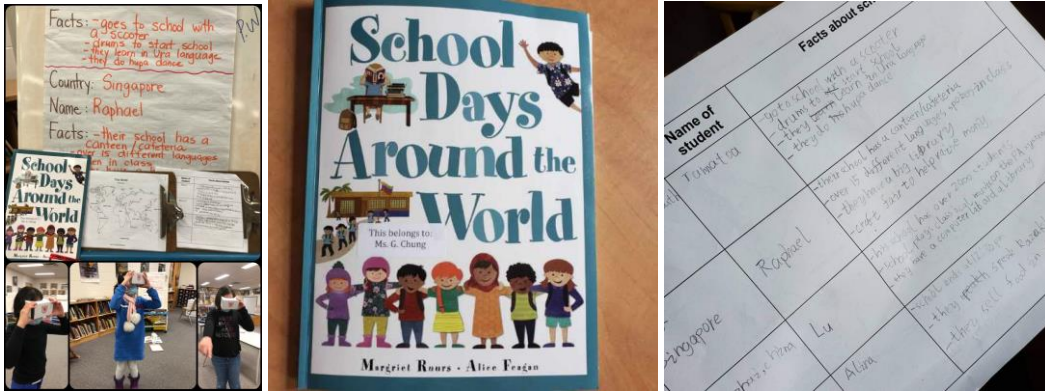
