Halloween Celebrations

Due to rising cases of COVID-19 in our city, Toronto Public Health and TDSB have implemented health and safety guidelines to celebrate Halloween. Therefore, this year, there will be some changes to how Halloween can be recognized and celebrated in schools. On <u>Friday, October 30th</u>, students may dress up for Halloween if they choose to do so. Halloween celebrations will occur in the classroom with the classroom cohort following the health and safety protocols.

- a costume mask is NOT a substitute for cloth mask or face covering and should not be worn over a cloth mask as it may make it difficult to breathe
- it is recommended that students NOT wear costume make-up, from below the eyes to ensure their face coverings stay clean
- students should NOT be bringing in treats to share with their peers
- large school wide Halloween events such as indoor parades will NOT occur
