## Healthy Bodies – introducing Sexual Education Discussions to children with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities

This is a learning opportunity and Virtual Office Hours for parents/guardians/caregivers and educators of students with developmental and/or intellectual disabilities, brought to you by TDSB OT/PT Services.
