Entry to School for Students with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)

The Entry to School program supports children who are entering kindergarten/grade 1 for the first time learning in a supportive play-based environment. The program consists of 6 months of group-based skill building, followed by 6 months of school transition support.

The Entry to School Program is appropriate for you and your child if:

- You have a child between the ages of three to six years old.
- Your child is entering kindergarten or grade one for the first time.
- Your child has a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).
- Your child is registered in the Ontario Autism Program (OAP).
- You have received a **letter of invitation** to participate in the program from the <u>Ministry of Children</u>, <u>Community and Social Services</u> (MCCS).

*Please note if you haven't received a letter or you have registered with Access OAP but are waiting to receive your OAP number, you can still call to register.

There are still spaces available in our program across Toronto. If you are interested please register online through the Toronto Autism Services Network <u>Entry to School Program – Toronto Autism Services</u> or by telephone call 1-833-575-KIDS(5437).

ASD After School Skills Development Program – Fall 2023 Session

Fall sessions of the ASD After School Leisure Program will run from November 28, 2023 to February 27, 2024, in-person and virtual. The program is available to students in Grades 4-10 who have been diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder. This program provides an opportunity for students to develop, build and enhance their social -communication skills through either weekly in-person or weekly virtual sessions.
