The Osler School Council is hosting Hands-On AI training, providing practical strategies and skills, strategies and ideas that employ AI tools to support learning, communication and daily routines.

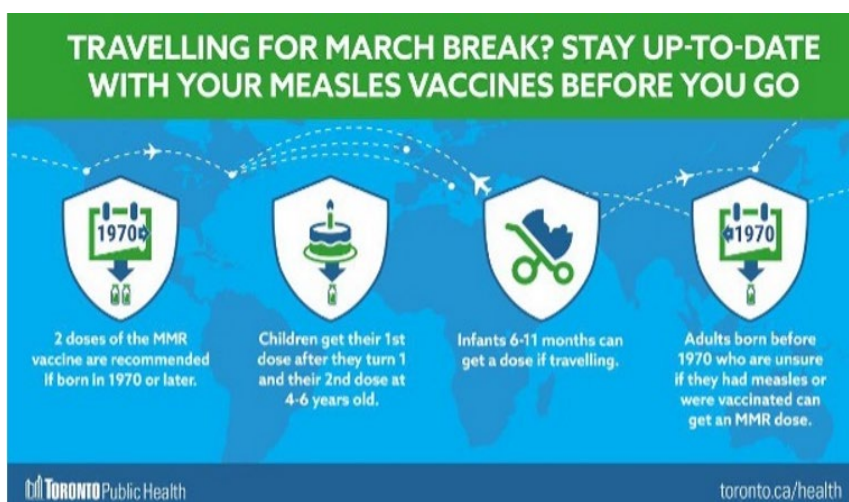


The presentation is on Monday, March 30th at 7:00 pm with an in-person and virtual (MS Teams) options.
