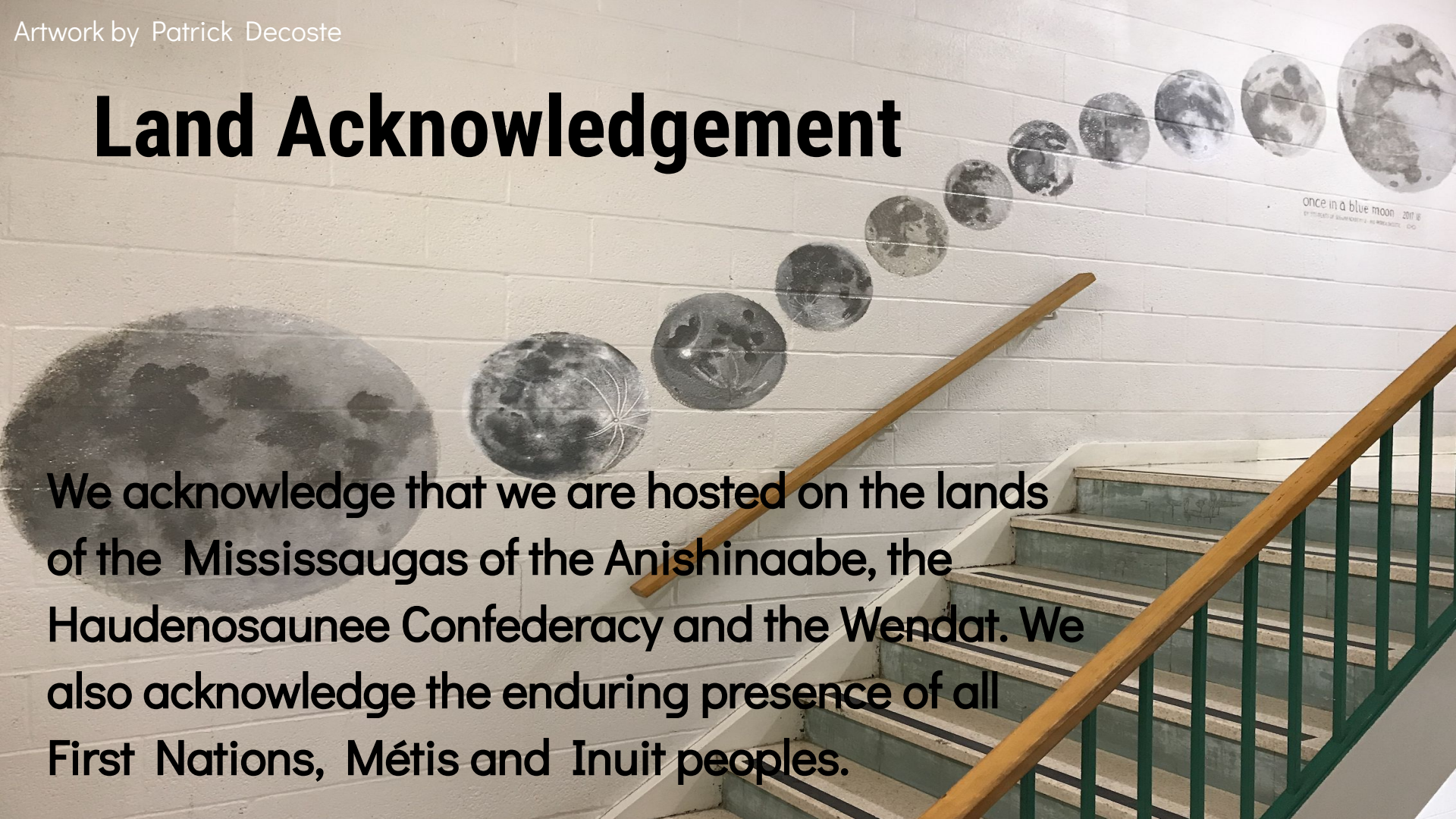


Land Acknowledgement

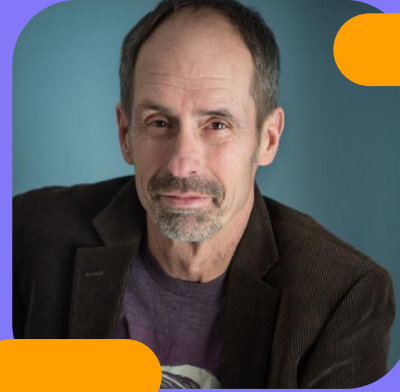

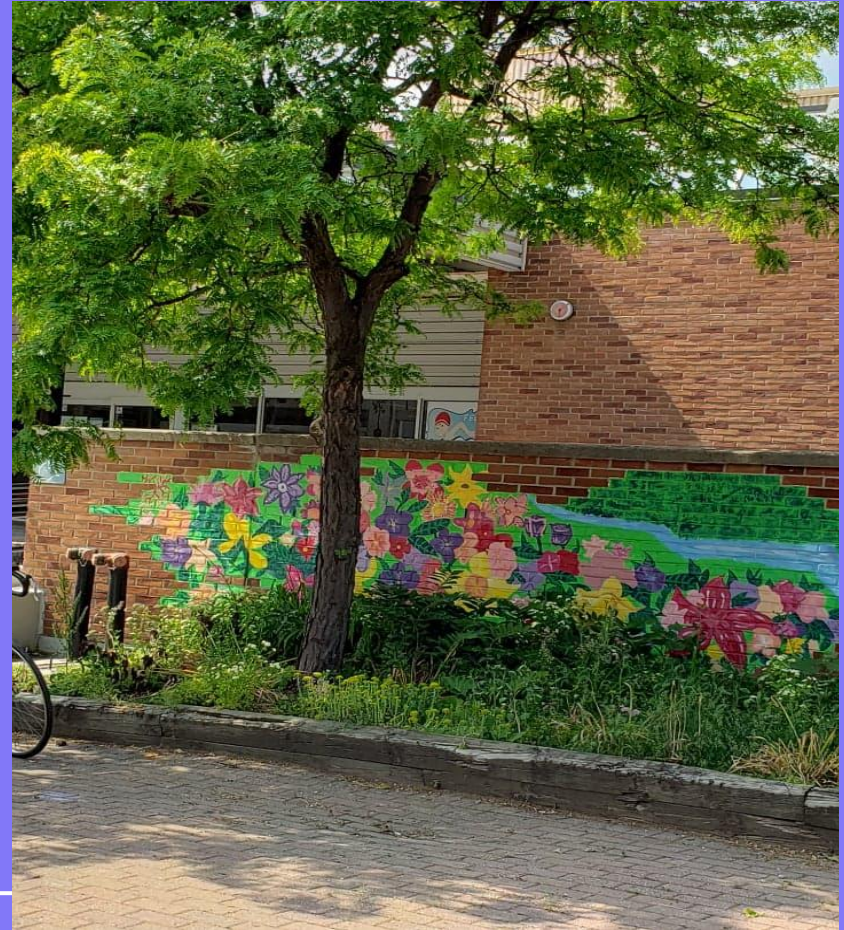
Subway Two Orientation

Subway Academy II is the only school in the TDSB that provides an independent study program for folks in Toronto under 21.

We are a small semestered alternative school offering grade 11 and 12 college, mixed, university and open level courses in the arts, humanities, social sciences, English and math.



Quad Calendar

This is the schedule for the year. Make sure that you know when the start and finish dates are for each quadmester. There may be further changes; we will keep you informed.

Quadmester Calendar

- **Quad 1:** Sept. 17 - Nov. 17 + Exams Nov. 18, 19
- **Quad 2:** Nov. 23 - Feb. 2 + Exams Feb. 3, 4
- **Quad 3:** Feb. 8 - April 20 + Exams April 21, 22
- **Quad 4:** April 23 - June 23 + Exams June 24, 25, 28

How will it work?

- You will continue to have flexibility and agency in your learning
- You will continue to meet with your teachers one-on-one, but this year it will happen virtually
- You will sign up for sessions weekly in a Google Doc
- A link to this Google Doc will be emailed to your student email account every Friday for the following week's sessions
- Each session will be 15 mins long
- You will meet with your teachers in Google Meet and/or Brightspace's Virtual Classroom
- If you prefer, you can have your session on the phone (you will need to accept calls from a private number)
- Attendance will be taken- if you are under 18, your parent/guardian will be notified at week's end if you miss your sessions.

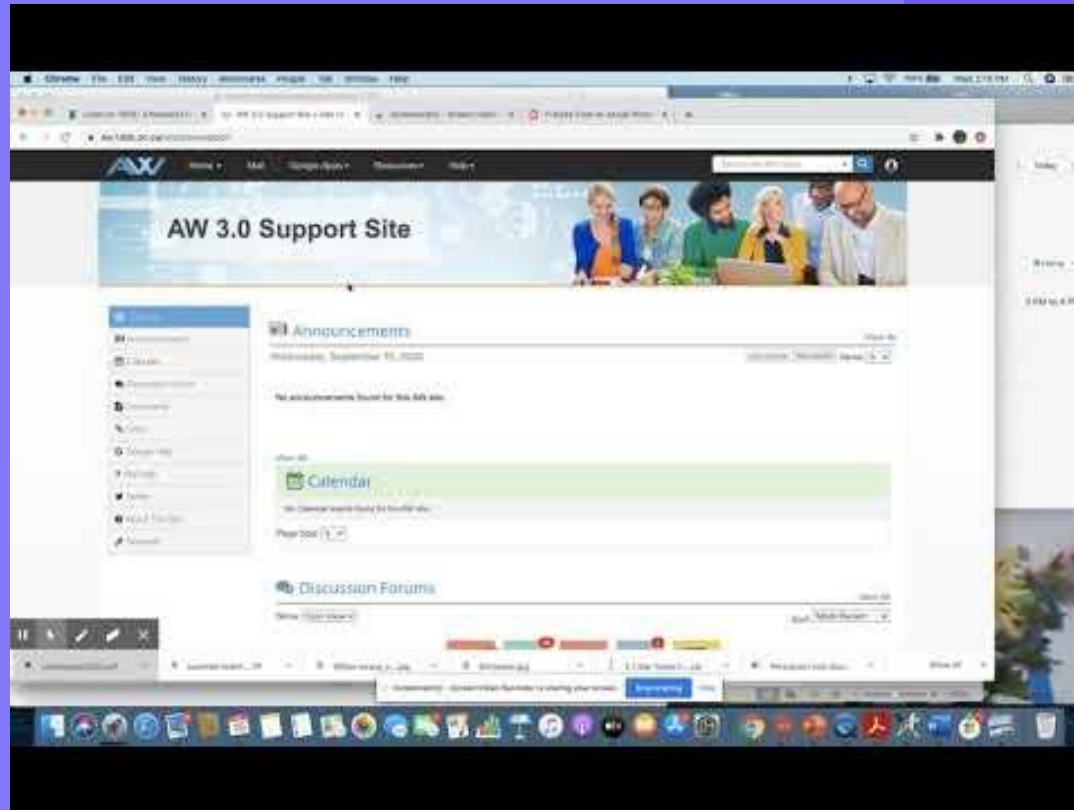

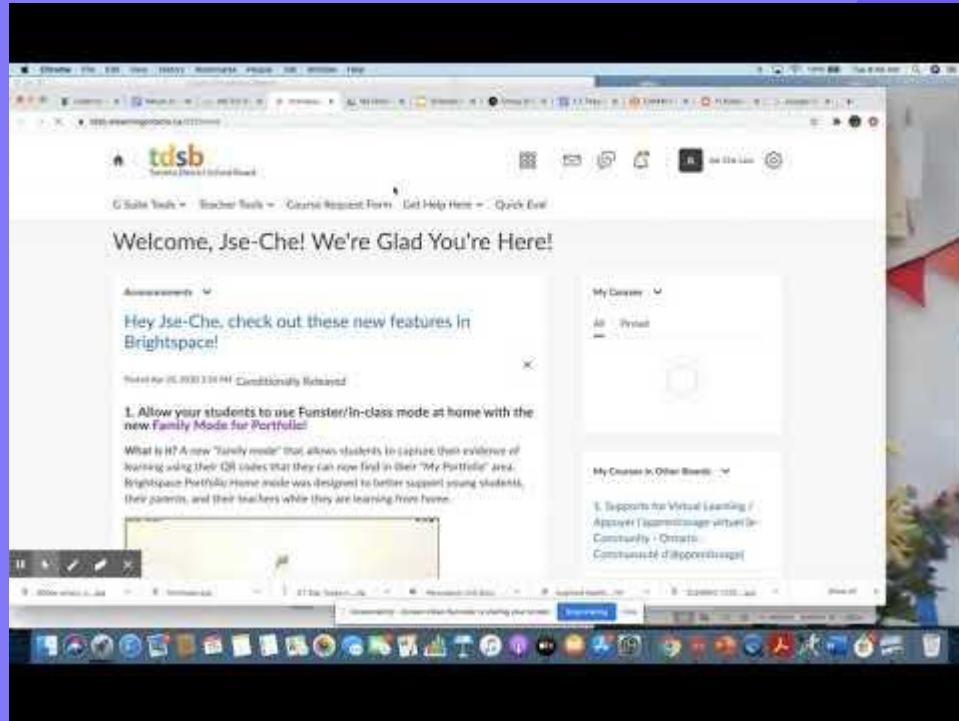

- Meets will be done in your teacher's preferred platform (either Google Meet or Virtual Classroom in Brightspace)

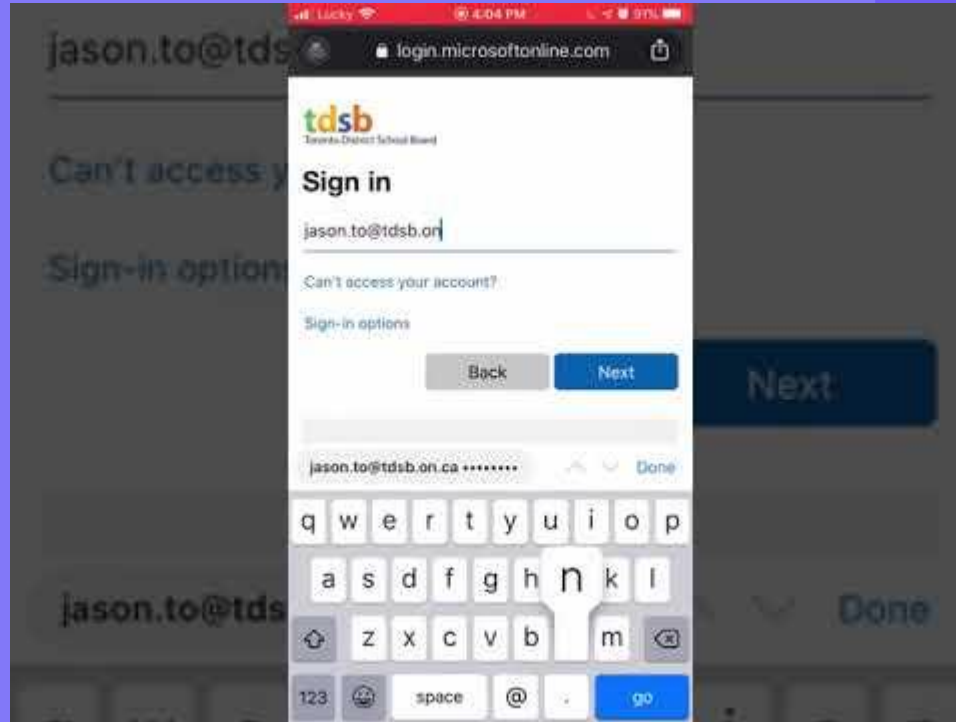

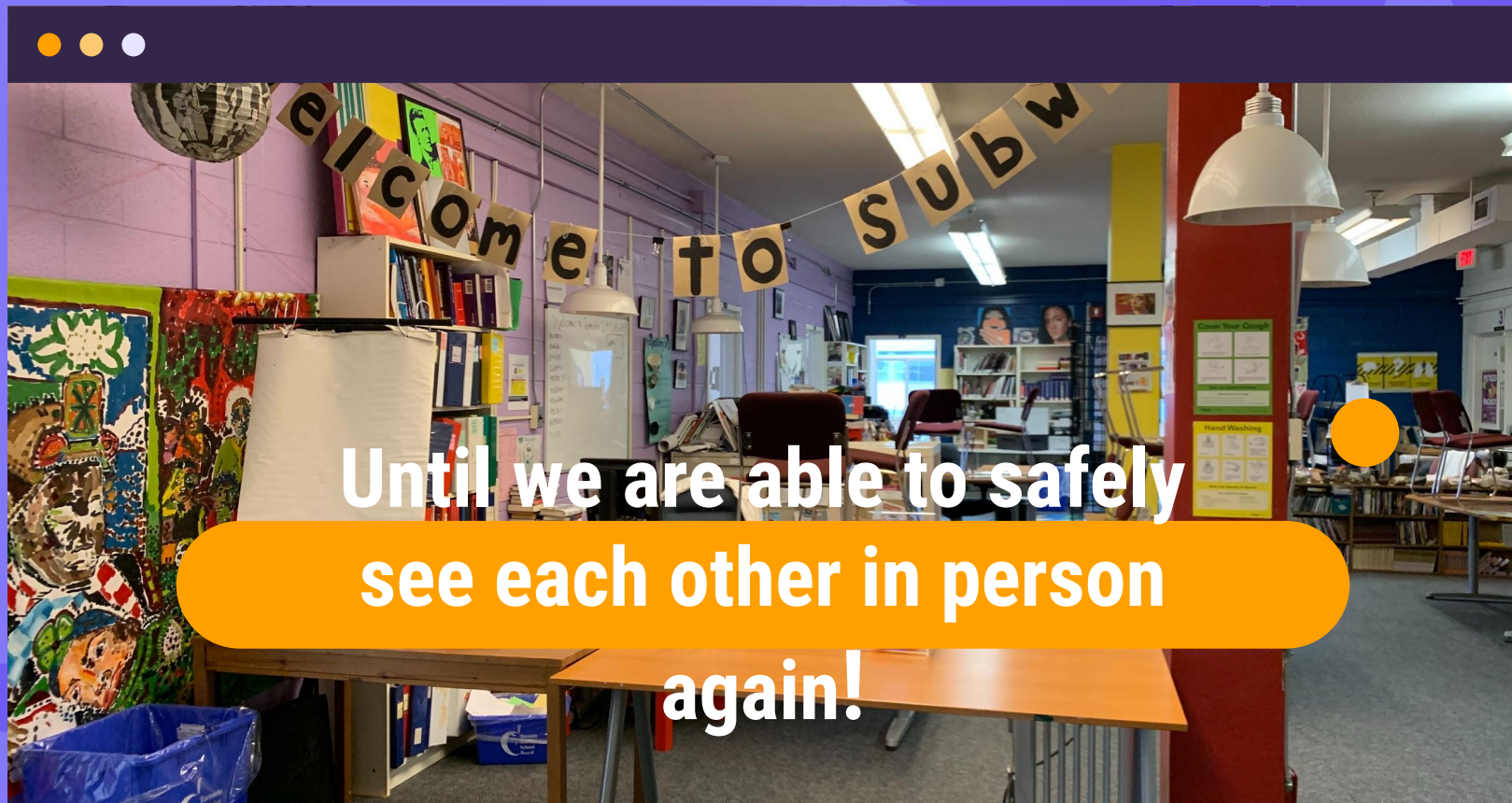
