## **Parking**

Please do not use the disabled parking space as a drop off zone. We've had a couple of unfortunate episodes with parents parking there and staff, with a valid disabled parking pass, not being able to access this space.

There is 15 minute parking along Grenview. Along both Grenview and Humbervale, you can drop off directly at the gate/opening.

#### Please do not park along the boulevard, blocking in our parking spots.

I will be seeking support from the parking authority to enforce parking restrictions. From what I can tell, parking in a disabled parking space without a valid permit is a \$450 fine.

I also ask, if you are using the legitimate parking spaces ("visitor parking"), that you **back into** them. We recently had a very close call with a parent backing out and almost hitting another parent and her dog.

I recognize that there is no drop off zone in the school, and there is no immediate plan to create one. Given that all families live in walking distance to the school, I ask that you consider walking your child whenever possible.
