Early Pickups:

If you need to pick up your child early from school for an appointment, please email the teacher and indrani.battersby@tdsb.on.ca to let them both know. Please plan to pick up during a natural transition time, such as the start of recesses or lunch. The best times are at the start of lunch at 11:40, or at recess, either at 10:05 or 2:00. If you come outside of these times during the school day, you'll likely have to wait for us to collect your child.

At lunchtime, unless it's an emergency, we ask that you stick to pick-up times at the start of the lunch hour or at the end of the lunch hour (11:40 and 12:40 for grades 1 to 5, and 11:40 and

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12:52 for FDK). Mid-lunchtime pick ups have safety implications for the school, as Ms. Staffford is often supervising in the schoolyard and Mrs. Battersby is securing entry and supporting ill or injured students in the office. Removing one of us from that duty to find and collect your child removes us from these responsibilities and can have safety repercussions.

If, on occasion, you are not able to make these times work, please email us ahead of time so we can look for a solution.
