## **\*\*Toronto Public Health - Student Immunizations\*\* IMPORTANT**

Maintaining high immunization coverage is essential for effectively preventing and controlling vaccine-preventable diseases. Toronto Public Health has begun sending notification letters to students in grades 2 to 5 (born 2015 to 2018) who are not in compliance with the ISPA.(Immunization of School Pupils Act) The last batch of notification letters will be sent on December 23, 2025, so all students not in compliance with the ISPA should receive their letter by the end of the year. It is very important that families report all immunizations to Toronto Public Health or submit a valid exemption. Doctors no longer submit vaccination information to Public Health. This is the responsibility of parents and caregivers. Suspensions for families not in compliance with the ISPA will begin in March. Please see below for information on reporting.

### **Illness/Sick Kids Saliva Program**

It appears that the flu season has already begun. Don't forget that if anyone in your family is sick, (children or adults) you can pick up one of the saliva test kits from the entrance and submit it for testing. Sick kids will test all samples for flu, pneumonia, covid, RSV and whooping cough. You will have results in 24 hours and if you test positive for any of those illnesses, sick kids will call you and let you know. Otherwise, you can get results online 24 hours later.
