 - Dance & Culture Asian Heritage Month \$480
 - o Girls Club cost of books for 11 girls is \$200. If do Gr 5 girls, will need another \$200.
 - Welcome to Kindergarten bags cost is \$688 (compared to \$728 last year) books, activities, hat, scissors, magnetic letters. Newsletters tied to the bags. \$18 each. Buy 32 or 33 of them. Any extra sunglasses leftover to include? Could look.
 - Alex Smith offered to help with reviewing bags for next year
 - Decodable books books mirror the teaching of complex sounds. FlyLeaf is gold standard and it is expensive. Have purchased a less expensive option, Syllasense (https://syllasense.com/) that is good. Got 300 books for \$1,690. Last year invested \$1350 and year prior was \$844; 3 years ago, invested over \$3,000 in books.
 - Biggest struggle for funds is athletics because student council can't pay for supply teachers.
 - Had to replace two laptops for teachers \$958 total. These attach to the whiteboards.
 - o Upcoming next year will need a number of new student Chromebooks. \$6K last year.
 - Jackie, can you estimate how many you will require each year.
 - \$4,016 requested and approved.
