Fundraising:

We will be starting our Chocolate sales again this year to help raise funds for the Spring Funfair, Buses, Scientist in the school etc....

Future fundraising initiatives include a winter ball, family winter 'Crafternoon', Holiday poinsettia sales and a Winter bake sale.

Financial:

Treasurer update: as of June, we had about \$6200, with a portion going to buses and scientists in the school. But a late influx to the account made it jump to \$5000, as we are not allowed to have more than \$1000 the exec made the decision to purchase 5 tables for lunches.

We also had to move from Pace to Alterna savings which is costing more as they charge a higher monthly fee (\$15) and deposit costs.

As of now we have \$955.00 in the account.
