PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:

Lots of exciting plans taking place at the moment. Ms. Capano reviewed the staff wish list for the year:

- Scientist in the School (\$300/classroom)
- Funding/Support for Greek Club in February (\$500)
- Funding/Support for raised garden bed
- Duffle Bag Theatre (\$1400)
- Outdoor toys for JK/SK's
- Busing for excursions (Approx \$400/bus)
