

STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE

The Toronto District School Board:

Does not provide accident insurance coverage for student injuries that take place on school property or during school sponsored activities

Accidents can and do happen resulting in injury and unexpected expenses for families

Some medical, dental or other costs are not paid for by OHIP or employer group plans

Parent(s)/guardian(s) are responsible for medical costs resulting from an accident

The Board has arranged a Student Accident Insurance policy through Reliable Life Insurance Company

- Participation is voluntary . Look at the plan options being offered and decide which plan might be right for your family. Many families have found that this insurance has paid for expensive medical, dental, rehabilitation and other supports to a child who has been injured
- Cost of the premium to be paid by parent(s)/guardian(s)
- All rates are a one-time yearly premium per student
- Plans range from the: Limited Plan at \$3.50, Bronze Plan at \$12.00 up to the Platinum Plan at \$26.50 (family rate for 3 or more children)
