Reorganization

As a result of changing student enrolment at our school, we were allotted an additional teacher to create smaller classes. We opened a new grade 5/6 classroom and lowered the numbers in all of our grade 1 to 8 classes to best support our students. Our grade 3/4 class changed to grade 3. In creating our new classes our teachers took time to ensure that we moved as few students as possible and ensured that all classes were balanced in academic and social strengths and needs, as well as gender.
