Teachers and school staff will be outside at 8:45 am to greet students.

Health and Safety

At Thorncliffe Park, we will continue to follow guidance from Toronto Public Health and the Ministry of Education. Below are ways we are keeping your child safe:

- We are a mask friendly school. Toronto Public Health strongly recommends wearing a mask, especially in indoor public settings. Masks will continue to be available for students who ask.
- All classrooms will have hepafilters.
- Students are reminded to do a daily self-assessment before coming to school and to stay home if they are sick.
- Rapid Antigen Test kits will be available to students upon request.

Families are asked to enter the front yard by the bus loop and the back yard by the park path or the path by Fraser Mustard.

If you are driving your child to school, please park in the mall parking lot and walk your child to the yard. The loop in front of the school is used for our school buses. The parking lot next to the school is for staff.
