

At Thorncliffe Park we work on learning activities designed to develop good character and help children make good choices. Our focus this month is on **KINDNESS AND CARING.**




School Council

In the photo you will see Liam on the right and two of our Grade 5 students helping with the donations. Please visit his website to learn more about his equipment bank



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
