
Meet your child's Teacher



- Set clear expectations for your child, and hold him or her accountable for his or her actions (for example, setting bedtimes and wake-up times, arriving to school on time).
- Teach your child to be environmentally responsible (e.g., picking up own litter, respecting property in the community).


At the end of the month, we will celebrate the learning of our students at our Character Assemblies.. Thank you for supporting our Character Development program.
