Our snack program has begun thanks to our amazing snack volunteers.


We were pleased to learn that our school would not need to reorganize. This means that all of our classes will remain the same. Excellent news!

We look forward to continued partnership with our families. Ms. Harvey Kerr, Mr. Fabbri and Ms. Roumanis










Classes have begun the year learning about the identities of the students in our school.


During our assembly, students shared their ideas about how students should feel at school.

- Send your child to school with a lunch in the morning










### **School Hours**

- The school office cannot call students for pick up between 2:45 - 3:15 pm. This is a busy time for students and staff




Thank you for helping your child to be on time and ready to learn at the beginning of class each day.

We continue to expand on the selected theme **Educate**. **Elevate**. **Excel**.






## **Islamic Heritage Month**


