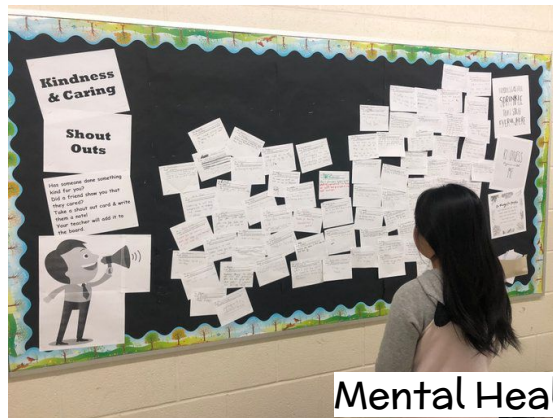
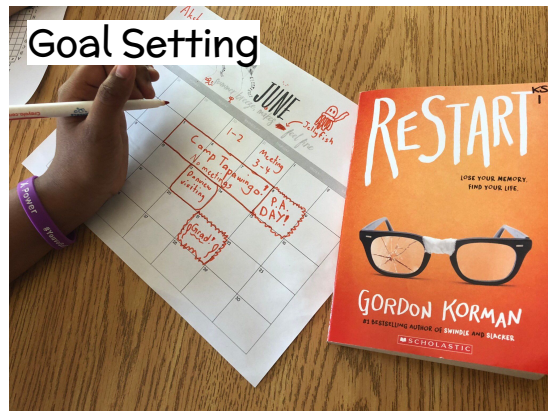
Grade 4:

Snack program was paused due to COVID. We are looking forward to its return when regulations allow.

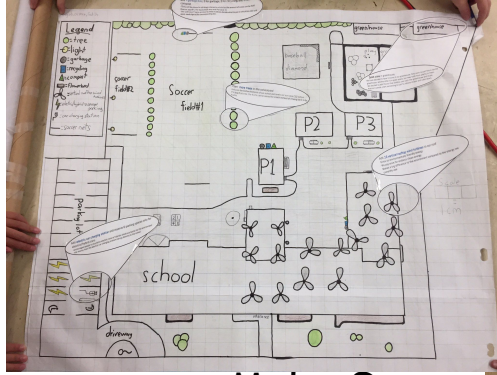

Transportation

For students that travel to Three Valleys by school bus, the pick up and drop off location is usually in front of your local school.

When you arrive at school, students assemble at the back of the school with classmates until the entry bell at 8:15 a.m.

When school ends at 2:45 p.m., students are escorted to the front of the school by a teacher for dismissal. A teacher will be on duty to make sure you get onto the right bus.

Bus routes are usually announced at the end of August.



Be patient in September! Buses may be running late as the driver learns the best roads to take to get to all the stops.

If you have questions about your route or pickup time, it's best to contact the bus company directly first.

Accepting Your Offer

If you decide Three Valleys is a good fit for you, you will need to complete a few tasks to accept your offer and be enrolled with us!

If you do not accept the offer, your child will remain enrolled at their current school. You will **not** receive another offer for a gifted placement.

1. Sign the **PERMISSION FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAM** form and send it to Mr. Freckelton AND your current school Principal kevin.freckelton@tdsb.on.ca
2. Complete the **Student Transportation Application** for bussing
3. Complete a **Medical form** if your child has any known medical conditions (e.g., Diabetes, asthma, allergies...) and send to Mr. Freckelton
