Teachers will be reaching out to families either by telephone or electronically to see what kind of access each student has to a computer/laptop/tablet and what kind of internet access is available. In addition, they will be asking about any exceptional challenges or conditions that your family may be facing while learning at home.

Next week, we will be entering "Phase 2" of Learning from Home. Teachers will have on-line learning environments established where there will be more formal instruction and interaction with students. We have yet to receive confirmation from the Ministry of Education as to the amount of time each day this will look like, and what the expectations for assessment and evaluation will be. However, we know that a great degree of flexibility will be required as each family's situation is different, and there may be additional challenges during learning time.
