## Principal's Message

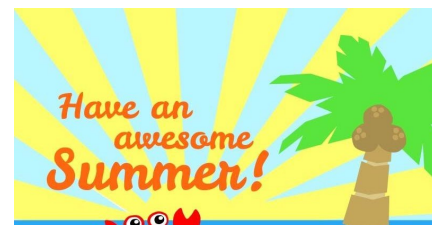
It is hard to believe that the 2021-2022 school year is coming to an end!
