## **Pre-Baccalaureate Programme**

## Procedure for Applying to the Pre-Baccalaureate Programme for the 2021/2022 Academic Year - please read carefully.

NEW: This year all applicants are required to complete an Application Google Form. The form requires that four mandatory documents are uploaded:

- 1) A copy of your most recent *Grade 8 Report Card* (both sides)
- 2) A copy of your **final** (dated June 2020) <u>Grade 7 Report Card</u> (all 4 sides)
- 3) A completed 2-sided <u>2021/2022 TDSB Optional Attendance Form</u>, including the Signature of your Current School Principal (or designate) at the bottom. (\*A link to this form is embedded within the Application Google Form).

**NOTE**: Even if the school you are applying to is your home school, you **must complete** the *TDSB Optional Attendance Form* because the IB Prep Programme is a Specialized Programme. Students outside the school catchment area, or who are not currently TDSB students, are also able to apply provided that the applicant is a City of Toronto resident.

4) A completed <u>Applicant's Personal Response</u> - this Response will require the applicant to share information about extra-curricular activities and answer two questions. (\*A copy of the Applicant's Personal Response can be obtained from the Application Google Form.)

The **Application Google Form** also requires both the applicant and a parent/guardian to agree to the <u>Statement of Understanding</u> relating to expectations and requirements of the Pre-Baccalaureate and International Baccalaureate Diploma Programmes. (<u>Note</u>: these expectations and requirements are outlined for your review on Pages 4 and 5 of this document.)

Each application will be assessed by considering the applicant's academic achievement, learning skills, teacher comments, and Applicant's Personal Response.

The completed Application Google Form, including all required documents, must be received by the deadline posted on Page 1 of this document. Late applications will not be considered.

Only COMPLETE applications will be processed.

Only ONE Application Google Form should be submitted per applicant. Once an applicant submits the Application Google Form, they will get a confirmation email.

# (New) Grade 9 Pre-Baccalaureate Selection Process for the 2021/2022 School Year for Victoria Park Collegiate Institute:

2. <b>Lottery</b> is conducted for Grade 9 Pre-Baccalaureate applicants who meet the admission criteria.	NO LATER THAN Thursday, February 4, 2021
3. Round 1 <b>Admission Offers</b> are emailed to selected applicants. This email specifies how long the offer is valid for and also contains a link to an <b>Acceptance Google Form</b> .	Friday, February 5, 2021
4. Qualified applicants not selected in Round 1 Admission Offers will be notified of their <b>Waiting List</b> number via email.	Friday, February 5, 2021
5. Round 1 selected candidates <b>accept Admission Offer</b> by (A) completing the <b>Acceptance Google Form</b> and (B) <b>submitting their course selection</b> on MyBlueprint by the posted deadline.	NO LATER THAN Thursday, February 11, 2021
6. Provided there is movement on the Waiting List, Round 2, 3 and 4 <b>Admission Offers</b> are emailed (see item 3 above). The email will specify how long each offer is valid for. Successful candidates accept offers (see item 5 above). The Final Round <b>Offers</b> are emailed.	Tuesday, February 23, 2021
7. Final Round selected candidates <b>accept Admission Offer</b> as per the instructions listed in item 5 above.	NO LATER THAN Friday, February 26, 2021

- Completion of additional homework, reading assignments, and course requirements during weekends, holidays and breaks may be required
- Students in the Pre-Baccalaureate Programme at Victoria Park Collegiate Institute are also expected to adhere to the school's Code of Conduct and all other school/board policies.

Students in the Pre-Baccalaureate and IB Diploma Programmes will do the following:

- In Grade 9, take English, French, Geography, Math, and Science with students in the IB Prep Programme stream.
- In Grade 9, take their arts and physical education electives with students from all stream levels.
- Take either Grade 10 Civics/Careers (two half courses) or Grade 10 Computer Science during the Grade 9 school year. If the Computer Science option is chosen, Civics & Careers must be taken in Summer School following the student's grade 9 year.
- Take both Grades 11 and 12 French in the Grade 11 school year, and write their IB French Examinations in May of the Grade 11 school year.
- Maintain a minimum of 80% in core subjects each year to continue in the Pre-Baccalaureate and IB Diploma Programmes.
- Students will be required to take Chemistry and either Biology or Physics. Due to the full IB subject load in Grades 11 and 11, IB Diploma students who wish to take a third Science, may do so in summer school following their Grade 10 and 11 school years.
- Understand that the family will be expected to pay the TDSB's anticipated fee of \$1500 for the Grade 11 IB Diploma year and \$1500 for the Grade 12 IB Diploma year for each student in the IB Diploma Programme (please note that board subsidies may be available.) Please note that there are no fees for the Pre-Baccalaureate Programme in Grades 9 and 10.
