- 1. The council planned and executed our first elections, and a byelection, for parent members and executive positions using the bylaws created in the previous year.
- 2. The council held 11 meetings, with childcare provided, throughout the year and all were well attended.
- 3. Council hosted fundraising and community engagement events such as:
  - 1. fall fun run
  - 2. winter craft night
  - 3. movie night
  - 4. disco night
  - 5. multiple pizza lunches, popcorn and freezie sales
  - 6. spring fun fair
- 4. Council financially contributed to the following initiatives that were identified as priorities by families and faculty:
  - 1. athletics equipment
  - 2. graduating class composites
  - 3. recognition ceremony items
  - 4. field trip busses
  - 5. in-school arts experience
  - 6. scientists in the classroom
  - 7. silver birch book club trip
  - 8. classroom supply supplement
  - 9. classroom computers supplement
  - 10. book fair top-up
- 5. The council waived the fun-fair admission for families in need
- 6. Sept 2019 election has been planned
- 7. Council did not carry through with a planned parent engagement presentation for which a PRO grant was issued
- 8. Council devised a protocol for the Tiago Daycare parents to have access to fundraising opportunities during Council events

- 9. Council agreed to an updated School Statement of Need
- 10. Council started posting public documents on the school website for easier access
- 11. Council wrote two letters to speak out against education cuts and requested the Superindendent to reconsider cuts to ISP
- 12. Council offered low cost spirit wear drive that was well recieved
