4. Treasury Report (Telma Da Silva)

- **Total Allocated Bucket Funds:** \$39,650; approx. \$29,650 spent so far
- On track for fundraising goal this school year
- Clubs and recreation bucket covered new pinnies and volleyballs
- Approved fund requests:
 - Reading intervention resources – 2 kits, 5 manipulatives, 6 workbooks (\$3,325 - \$900 approved since rest is coming from literacy bucket)
 - Learning resource room – sensory support items (approx. \$1,500)
 - Grade 4 and 5 math workbooks from My Math Path (\$135)
 - Garden update (approx. \$1,000)
 - New seating for the library (\$10,500)
