Action Items & Year-End Reminders


-  **Student Medication Pickup:** If your child has medication, EpiPens, or inhalers stored in the school office, please come to the main office to pick them up before dismissal on Thursday.
-  **Lost & Found (Final Call):** Please remind your child to check the Lost and Found this week. Parents are also welcome to visit the school to browse the tables. **Note:** Any items remaining after Thursday afternoon will be donated to charity.
-  **Families Moving/Leaving:** If your family is relocating and will not be returning to Westmount in September, please return the pink form that went home last week (if you haven't already). This is vital for our September staffing and enrollment planning.

Westmount Annual Fun Day!

Our Annual Fun Day is happening **Tuesday, June 23 from 9:30 AM – 11:30 AM!**

- **The Setup:** Students will be outdoors for about two hours, moving through various activity stations with their classes.
- **Beat the Heat:** To keep everyone hydrated and energized, we will have a designated **Cooling Station** with freezies and a **Rest Station** with school snacks.
- **What to Wear & Bring:**

-  Running shoes
-  A hat & sunscreen
-  A refillable water bottle, **clearly labeled** with your child's name and teacher's name.

 **Note:** If your child requires any special accommodations to safely participate in this outdoor activity, please reach out directly to their classroom teacher as soon as possible.

Construction & Traffic Alert (BFPP Update)

Please plan your commute accordingly for the week of June 22:

- For the remainder of June, active construction will take place on **Drury Lane**.
- **Chapman Rd** is fully open; however, due to ongoing restoration work, you may experience vehicular delays.
- **Best School Access:** Avoid accessing Chapman Rd from Royal York Rd. Instead, use alternate routes: La Rose Ave → Arcade Dr → Chapman Rd **OR** Scarlett Rd → Chapman Rd.

Coming September 2026: Transition to a Balanced Day

For families returning to Westmount in the fall, please note that we are transitioning to a **Balanced Day model** for the 2026–27 school year. Westmount is proud to be one of 15 schools within the TDSB piloting this schedule next year.

- **How it works:** The standard 300-minute instructional day will be broken into three 100-minute blocks, separated by two 40-minute nutrition and outdoor breaks.
- **New Hours:** When students return on **September 8, 2026**, our school day will begin at **9:10 AM** and dismissal will be at **3:30 PM**.
