KIMDERGARTEM OPEN HOUSE

Calling all new Kindergarten students to Whitney!

If you have a child who will be entering Junior Kindergarten in September 2018, we invite you join us on Tuesday February 27th beginning at 6:00 pm. If you know of a neighbour with children ready for JK this coming September, please pass this information on to them. Children who will be four years old prior to December 31, 2018 (born in 2014) may enter Junior Kindergarten next school year. If a child is born in October, November, or December of 2014, parents/ guardians have the option to begin Junior Kindergarten in September 2019 in all TDSB schools.

Kindergarten Registration at Whitney is expected to begin the beginning of February for the majority of the new students. Registrations can be taken at any point until the first day of school in September (and beyond for anyone living in our school district). In October 2016, the House of Commons voted unanimously to recognize every January as Tamil Heritage Month. January was chosen as it coincides with one of the most important celebrations for Canadians of Tamil heritage, the Thai

Pongal Harvest Festival. Over 75 million Tamil people around the world irrespective of their religion celebrate Thai Pongal. This celebration offers thanks to the sun and cattle for an abundant harvest.

In 2014, the Government of Ontario, with full consent, passed legislation proclaiming January as Tamil Heritage Month. TDSB proudly marked Tamil

Heritage Month for the first time in 2016.

The theme for Tamil Heritage Month (THM) this year is **Pillars of our Past; Shaping the Path Ahead**. To explore this theme, the THM Planning Committee is inviting students across the system to learn about the rich culture of Tamil people, and how their ancestry can shape their future. The committee is also accepting submissions for the Tamil Heritage Month series of contests in the three following categories: Narratives, Original Artwork, and Speeches.

Students are asked to respond to the question, "How could the narratives and history of our cultural past shape our identity as Canadians today?"

Please note the deadline for the Narrative and Original Artwork categories is noon on Wednesday, January 17th, 2018.

All winning entries will be announced on Saturday, January 27th during the Celebration of Tamil Heritage.

TUESDAYS

Kinder Science (JK/SK) - Junior Adventurers introduces kinders to many of the world's sciences. From birds and water to structures and music, each week brings a different topic and children will create a special art piece each week! (8 weeks/ \$144.25)

DIY MashUp (grades 1-4) - In this 8 week session you will get to create 4 awesome projects from 4 different themes! Using a variety of materials and learning new skills, you will get to create 1 DIY Emoji project, 1 DIY Puppet project, 1 DIY Duct Tape project and 1 DIY Fashion project!
