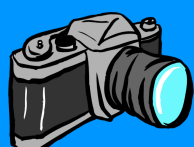
from the principal

Dear Parent(s)/ Guardian(s)/ Caregiver(s):

Welcome to a new school year at Whitney Public School! It was wonderful to see so many people out at our Celebration of Learning (Curriculum Night) this week.

Every September, schools review actual student enrolment as compared to initial projections from last April, and reorganize classes where required. We do our best to plan for the new school year, but there are always factors, such as new or departing students, that might affect how classrooms are organized. In addition, to ensure smaller class sizes, the Ministry of Education sets out specific class size requirements to benefit student learning.

As a result of student enrolment at our school, we will need to reorganize our Junior Division, in particular the two Grade 5/6 classes to best support our students. For your child, if they are in Grade 6, they will remain with their current teacher in their current Room. Students in Grade 5 will have a new teacher in Room 304. We will try to update you with the name of the teacher as soon as interviews have been completed and approval has been granted. Changes to classes at our school will take place by October 2, 2017.

We know that for students and parents, changing classes may be difficult and may require an adjustment period. Students will be supported as they transition through these classroom changes. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me or your child's teacher.

The essence of the day remains the same with Spirit Days, Pizza lunches, and assemblies taking place on these days. There will be opportunities to have students recognized and to celebrate what has been going on in their classrooms. The main change in these days is the content and opportunity to have either a **Character Education focus (TDSB Character Traits)**, an **Equity focus**, or **both**.

We are also looking to focus on goal setting and self-improvement. This gives us 10 opportunities in the year to reflect on how we are doing and think of a way to improve or do better. It might be related to academics, work habits, social interactions, kindness...the possibilities are many. Students and Staff can focus on something meaningful to them.

In the month of September, our focus was on **RESPECT**. Over the past month, staff discussed this theme in the classroom, and students shared quotes over the announcements that were reflective. 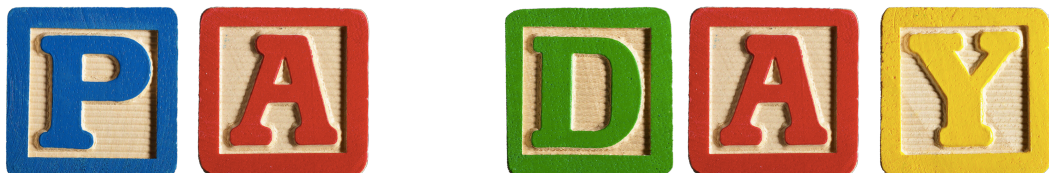

Orange Shirt Day

(Declared annually across Canada)

On Friday September 29th, students and staff across the TDSB will come together and wear Orange Shirts to recognize the harm that the Residential School System did to First Nations, Métis and Inuit children and to recognize that **"Every Child Matters."**

Orange Shirt Day is a movement that officially began in 2013 but in reality it began in 1973 when six year old Phyllis Webstad entered the St. Joseph Mission Residential School, outside of Williams Lake, BC. The date, September 30, was chosen because that was the time of the year the trucks and buses would enter the communities to "collect" the children and deliver them to their harsh new reality of cultural assimilation, mental, sexual and physical abuse, shame and deprivation.

Honouring this day shows our commitment to Reconciliation.

Walk to School

International Walk to School Day is a global event that involves communities from more than 40 countries walking and biking to school on the same day. It began in 1997 as a one-day event. Over time, this event has become part of a movement for year-round safe routes to school and a celebration – with record breaking participation – each October.

We will observe this day at Whitney on **Wednesday October 4th** this year. Each month this year at our school, we will have a Walking Wednesday (usually the first Wednesday of each month) where we will encourage all students and adults to walk, cycle, scooter, or skateboard to school. We will award the **"Golden Shoe" trophy** to the class that has the highest percentage of participants each time.

Come out to meet Christopher Rzepa, our new Principal. Enjoy delicious BBQ, groove to great music and show your support for Whitney!!

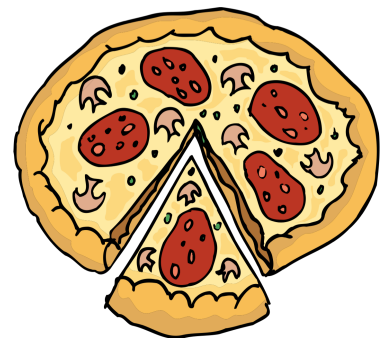
Spirit Together Equity Pizza

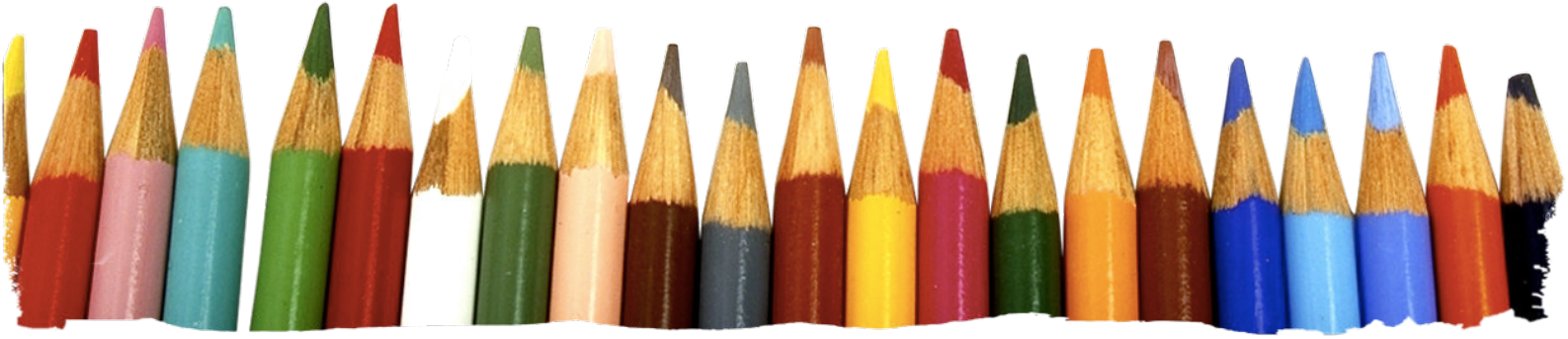

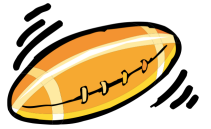

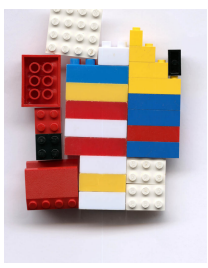
