1. Approval of October Agenda

2. Approval of September Minutes

3. Principal's Update – Jenny Georgiou

- The Kindergarten classes are settling in after the two-part reorganization.
 - Phase one was mentioned in last month's minutes and amounted to one new Kindergarten classroom with 15 students (moved from existing classrooms), one teacher and no ECE.
 - In the second phase, The Board allotted us a new ECE to further reduce our class sizes. Last week, the classes were reshuffled so that there are now 5 classrooms with approximately 25 students in each one
- HPE: Today was the South Conference cross country meet at Ashbridge's Bay and we had a large group of Grade 1-6 students attend.
 - We're waiting for the official results to find out if we have students (Grades 3 and up)
 who will be moving forward to the next meet.
- EQAO: we just received our Individual Student Reports (ISR) and we did really well.
 - The ISRs will be going home this week.
- Tomorrow we begin our CCAT (Canadian Cognitive Abilities Test) for the Grade 3's.
 - It's a 3-part standardized gifted screening test > not a test that can be studied for.
 - This is a new process.
- School Statement of Needs: reminder that this needs to be completed for this year.
 - The Executive Committee will update and submit it.
- Request: There's a lot of litter in the wooden balance beam playground near Dandylion and no garbage can close by. Can we consider adding one to that area of the yard?
 - There used to be a garbage can but it was often used for inappropriate garbage (placed there by teens and adults outside of school hours) > the litter in that area now is likely a combination of student and non-student (mostly food and wrappers).
 - The lighting situation in that area could be improved > perhaps adding more light would deter people from hanging out there at night.
 - Admin will look into both the garbage can and additional light source and discuss it with the Safe Schools Committee as well.



4. Committee Reports

Committee members provided an update of upcoming and ongoing initiatives.

Executive Elections - Angelina Diassiti

- The 2016/2017 Council has now been dissolved and we will elect the new members of the Executive Committee.

 - Motion to vote in the new Executive Committee. Motion carried.

Budget Vote - Angelina Diassiti

- The proposed budget for this school year was circulated for approval.
- Do new events and programming get added in ad hoc?
 - New funding requests and event proposals should be submitted using the *General Funding Request* and *Event Proposal* forms found on our <u>website</u> (Council and Communications section of the Forms and Letters page)
 - Submissions are then voted on by Council members at meetings (assuming we have the funds available).
 - All things being equal, if we make what we expect from our recurring events, we should have some extra money this year to spend on new initiatives.
- Do we foresee a need for new technology this year? After the large technology spend over the last two years, at this point we don't.
- Joel sent the Funding Request form to the staff and there may be some submissions coming in > please try to submit them before the November meeting.
- For some line items, the budget amount has decreased this year > the team leads feel that for whatever reason they can work within the budget set.
- Some line items have not been active in recent years but are left on the budget as a reference (e.g. sports uniforms that were purchased a few years ago) > The Council will fund things that we feel are worthwhile and that cannot be funded through the TDSB.
- In other cases there are new line items for things that have been newly approved (e.g. the Internet Safety seminar happening this month that was approved last year).
- What is Wilkitchen? It's a community building cooking event.
 - We host one as part of Fun Fair and we have some interest in reviving it as a standalone event.



- We had one two years ago (but are unsure if we did last year) so the line item remains on the budget.
- How many Movie Nights do we plan on doing this year? They're great for community building but don't seem to be huge money makers.
 - The dates haven't been determined yet. The committee is reorganizing some aspects
 of the event and we'd like to give them some time to work things out before we
 make a decision about the event's future.
 - Perhaps we can have 4 events instead of 6 to draw a larger crowd? It may get to a
 point where having too few events doesn't justify the licensing cost. We're working
 on calculating costs and compiling data around what dates and titles draw the biggest
 crowds so that we can figure out the best way to run the program.
 - Since it's a suggested donation at the door, have we looked at raising the concession prices and getting donations of food or trading advertising for free goods? We do get a discount on food, but advertising within the school can be problematic.
 - A lot of people really enjoy movie night even if it doesn't bring in much money so there is more to discuss once we have more data.
 - We will revisit the movie night discussion in June before we renew the license.
- Motion to approve the budget for this year. Motion carried.

5. New Business
