Suicide Prevention

Talking to Your Kids About Suicide

It's important to talk openly and honestly with your kids about mental health, including suicide. Let them know that it's okay to feel sad or down sometimes, but that it's important to talk to someone if they're feeling overwhelmed or hopeless.

If your child hears a friend talking about suicide, encourage them to:

- Listen actively and non-judgmentally. Let your friend know you're there for them and that you care.
- Encourage them to seek help. Suggest they talk to a trusted adult, such as a parent, teacher, counselor, or therapist. Ask your child who are the adults they feel comfortable with speaking to at school.
- Offer to go with them to get help. This can show your friend that you're serious about helping them.
- Don't keep it a secret. If your friend is in immediate danger, call 911 or a crisis hotline.

Remember: You're not alone. There are many resources available to help you and your child.




