Three Ways to Get Involved

All parents/caregivers of students registered in the school are invited to attend meetings and events, help out and participate in their school community. However, only elected Voting Members vote on items brought to School Council.

Attend a meeting

School Councils have between 4-10 meetings each school year and this is an opportunity for you to speak to issues that affect the school community and student achievement.



Every school needs volunteers to get stuff done. You can volunteer once or many times. Small groups, called subcommittees, work on projects that need your helping hands. Ask a council member or a school staff to get involved.

3 Join as a Voting Member

Every September a new group of caregivers/parents are elected through a democratic voting process. Members guide the work of School Council through-out the year, supporting students and parents/caregivers.
