

Registration for Kindergarten at Wilmington Elementary School begins February 21, 2019. Please call 416-395-2180 to make an appointment.

Children born 2015 and who will be four by December 31, 2019 can start Junior Kindergarten in September 2019. Only parents or legal guardians can register a child for TDSB programs.

Registration Information:

Step 1

- Access to the online registration system will open on Monday, February 4, 2019 at 9 a.m.
- Please note: Once you have completed the online portion of the registration process, you will receive a confirmation e-mail, including information about next steps (e.g. when to visit the school). Please be sure to check your Inbox and Junk Mail folder to avoid missing the e-mail. You will also receive an e-mail with a link to complete a *Developmental History Form* for your child online. If you choose to complete this form online, please let the school staff know when you visit in person that you have already submitted this information.
- For parents with a child (ren) in our onsite Daycare please get a registration package from Teresa Tomassi.

Step 2

- The following documents are required when you visit the school to complete the registration:
 - Proof of age (birth certificate, Canadian passport, Canadian Citizenship card or certificate or baptismal record)
 - Proof of address, including any two of the following <u>current</u> documents: lease or deed, car registration, utility bill, residential telephone bill, moving bill, property tax bill, health card, bank statement, credit card statement, or correspondence from a government agency.
 - Proof of immunization (the card that shows a list of needles your child has received)
 - Verification of date of arrival, if your child was not born in Canada. Families who are permanent residents and refugee claimants may register directly at the school. Children without immigration status are welcome in our schools and information about them or their families will not be shared with immigration authorities. To register, please visit the International Programs and Admissions Office at 5050 Yonge Street, on the main floor, for a TDSB school admission letter.
