Interviews provide an opportunity for Parents-Guardians and Teachers to share important information about students to support their success at school. In order to continue to **build relationships, cameras must be on during the interview.**

<p><u>Credit Rescue Days</u></p> <p>Credit Rescue is an early intervention initiative to support student achievement. The TDSB has determined the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• There will now be 2 Credit Rescue Days at each mid-semester (one day for week 1 courses and one day for week 2 courses) and 3 Credit Rescue days at the <u>end of each semester.</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• On November 5, we will be running a Credit Rescue Day schedule for Week 1 courses and another Credit Rescue Day schedule for Week 2 courses on November 8, 2021.• Students will receive their <u>mid-term mark</u>, and those students with marks 60% or lower (at-risk) will provided with opportunities to complete assessments and receive the necessary supports with their subject teacher.

Virtual Parent Teacher Interviews	<p>Virtual Parent Teacher Interviews will occur on Tuesday, November 9, 2021 from 1-3 p.m. in the afternoon and 6 – 8 p.m. in the evening.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On November 9, 2021, parents/guardians will click on the Teacher Zoom Meeting Link beside their appointment slot. We recommend clicking on this link 10 minutes in advance of your meeting. • The teacher will admit you into the meeting and start the parent teacher interview. • Please note that teachers will be explaining this process to their students this week also.
