Start of Year Forms Can be Completed Online Starting September 9, 2021!

As part of the TDSB's Digital Transformation strategy and in support of a Board directive, a selection of school Start Up forms have been made available to parents/guardians this September in digital format using Permission Click. This model is easy, simple, and secure and will help streamline the process of a number of standard forms as well as save paper and resources.

All parents and caregivers should have received a broadcast message that was sent by TDSB to all parents/guardians (priority 1 or 2 contacts with an email recorded in Trillium) through School Messenger on Thursday, August 30, 2021 to communicate the new process for digital forms.

How does it work?

After your child's first day of school on September 9, an email was automatically sent to the parent/guardian listed as the primary or secondary contact with an email address on file with the school. The email came from TDSB Online Form (noreply@tdsb.on.ca) and would take you to a secure site to complete and submit your child's forms.

What forms can I complete online?

The forms available online include the following:

- Consent Form Package

 - Permission to leave school in severe weather conditions
- Use of parent/guardian email address
- Medical Information Form
- Acknowledgement and Declaration of:

An email has automatically sent to the parent/guardian who is the primary or secondary contact (Priority 1 or 2) with an email in Trillium (see <u>FAQ</u> for explanation). The email includes a link for parents/guardians to complete the forms for each of their children and was sent the next school day after attendance was taken, and the student became active in Trillium. The email came from the <u>noreply@tdsb.on.ca</u> email address. **Please check your junk mail if you have not received it directly in your in box.**

You are encouraged to complete these forms online ASAP (many thanks to those who have done so already). If you would prefer paper copies to be sent home, please have your child to come the main office, where they can pick up a package.

Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT) and Grade 9 EQAO Math Test

The OSSLT is designed to measure whether students are meeting the minimum standard for literacy across all subjects up to the end of Grade 9. Successful completion of the literacy test is one of the requirements to earn an Ontario Secondary School Diploma. All students across the province write this test.

This year, the literacy graduation requirement for all students graduating during the 2021–2022 school year <u>has been waived</u>, graduating students do not need to take the OSSLT.

All current grade 10 and 11 students however are expected to write the literacy test (although some exemptions may apply). Students will have two opportunities to pass the OSSLT this school year. The first exam will take place in November and the second opportunity will be given in the spring.

Grade 9 students in the regular academic and RUSH program will be required to write the grade 9 EQAO math test. Although this test is not a requirement to graduate, all students (with limited exemptions) are expected to participate in the test. Whilst the exact date of the test is to be determined, it is expected that students will be write the test in January 2022.

A separate letter will be sent to families, providing more detailed information regarding both tests.

Homework Help

Our after-school homework help has begun. Students can sign up for extra help every Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday after school. Tutoring takes place in the library from 3:00 pm – 4:00 pm. This is in addition to the support that is being offered by the classroom teachers before school and/or at lunch times.
