January has been recognized as Tamil Heritage Month since 2016. Toronto has the largest population of Tamil people outside of South and Southeast Asia with thousands of TDSB students and staff members identifying as Tamil. In the most recent Census of 2016, 189,600 individuals in Canada have self-identified as having knowledge of the Tamil language. This year TDSB's Tamil Heritage Month Committee has recognized the theme to be Community. Belonging. Joy - 步心多心 步吭访访 步访访多可下心 Belonging comes with a sense of acceptance and inclusion for who you are, and there is great joy that comes from knowing you belong within any given community. And the beat goes on... In Music Class



Full Day Kindergarten Registration



Kindergarten registration at Yorkview P.S. will begin in February. Please encourage your neighbours who have children born in 2019 (Junior Kindergarten) and 2018 (Senior Kindergarten) to register online and the office will confirm registrations. In order to register, parents will need to present the following:

- □ identification to prove residency (NOT a cell phone bill or driver's license)
- □ a letter from the Property Management Office indicating the names of the people who live in your unit
- □ child's birth certificate or passport or permanent resident card
- □ immigration papers, if necessary
